Meeting Minutes

Jan 25 Meeting

- Andrew Bruce (Team Lead), Aaron Steele (Team Lead), Gina Watkinson (Wiki Editor), James Craven (Wiki Editor), Dale Kronkright, Loa Ludvigsen and Adam Neese present.
- Those present introduced themselves to each other.
- AB spoke about the idea that our first task would be to individually come up with a contents lists for the X-ray Wiki page. That we would then compile these contents lists in the hope that this would produce a concise lists of topics to cover and some discussion about the content and order that these topics should be approached on the Wiki.
- Discussion: We discussed the “X-ray bibliography”.
- Discussion: The Wiki doesn’t have to be just text, could be a video too etc.
- Discussion: Case studies – a survey of museums equipment, processes etc
- Discussion: Round robin image quality tests.
- Discussion: “Community Projects” section of Wiki. E.g. case studies on museums purchasing new X-ray kit.
- Discussion: The sooner we can get content on the Wiki the better, remember that the Wiki is to be dynamic, it’s not about publishing to a deadline. The timeline we work to will be set by the team leads.
- Action: It was agreed that we will go ahead and produce these Wiki contents each (The team leads will be in touch about this).
- Action: That the time which we meet will be one hour earlier than this meeting (e.g. this would be 3pm GMT / 10am ET.)
- Action: The Googledrive is now set up and has some content online.
- Action: Have checked and confirmed that everyone present in this first meeting is happy to have their name and contact details shared within the group. There is now a contacts document on the Googledrive.
- Action: The AIC X-Ray Topic Group will meet for the first time properly via MS Teams in March (Date TBC. The team leads will be in touch about this).
