3. **Presentation by David Messinger, 25 min** — "Imaging a future for the past: recovery of lost texts with a low-cost MSI system" – The presentation will be recorded and shared through the Imaging Wiki.

Dr. Messinger received a Bachelor's degree in Physics from Clarkson University and a Ph.D. in Physics from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He is currently a Professor, the Xerox Chair in Imaging Science, and Director of the Chester F. Carlson Center for Imaging Science at the Rochester Institute of Technology where he was previously the Director of the Digital Imaging and Remote Sensing Laboratory. His research focuses on projects related to spectral image analysis using physics-based approaches and advanced mathematical techniques with particular emphasis on the use of data-driven techniques from the graph theory and manifold learning literature. Applications of this research have ranged from airborne and space-based imaging for archeology and disaster response to cultural heritage imaging.
