3. **Presentation by Athanasios Velios, 25 min** — This presentation will focus on the [Linked Conservation Data \(LCD\)](#). A project and a network of partners working on improving access to conservation documentation records. The project is relevant to imaging specification in relation to metadata and the description of images to aid retrieval. The presentation will cover the main objectives of the project and discuss how images can be included as resources within conservation documentation records expressed as Linked Data. The presentation will be a starting point for considering the interaction of the IWG with LCD.

Athanasios Velios is one of the investigators of the Linked Conservation Data project alongside Kristen St. John (Stanford Libraries). He is Reader in Documentation at the University of the Arts London. He trained as a conservator and completed a PhD in the Royal College of Art and Victoria & Albert Museum Conservation (RCA/V&A Conservation) program run in association with Imperial College on Computer Applications to Conservation. He developed the condition survey form and database for the St. Catherine Library Conservation Project working with Prof. Nicholas Pickwood. He is one of the editors of the Language of Bindings Thesaurus and the CIDOC Conceptual Reference Model.

- A creative solution to an everyday problem
- Projects that didn't go as planned or have you stumped
